B. Organization of work

The proposed organization of work for the eighth meeting of the Regional Committee of United Nations Global Geospatial Information Management for Africa has been prepared taking into account the continued impact of the coronavirus disease (COVID-19) on the working arrangements of the region's constituencies. It has been decided that the eighth meeting will be held in person from 24 to 28 October 2022, in Addis Ababa.

The eighth meeting of the Regional Committee will be divided into a workshop segment, which will be held on 24, 25 and 28 October, and a formal segment, which will be held on 26 and 27 October. The meeting will be colocated with the eighth session of the Statistical Commission for Africa to maintain and strengthen the synergy between the geospatial and statistical communities in all domains of applicability.

In the light of the co-location, the first day of the formal segment (Wednesday, 26 October) will begin at 11 a.m. and end at 5:30 p.m. (UTC+3).



The second and final day of the formal segment (Thursday, 27 October) will also be held from 11 a.m. to 5.30 p.m.
