1. Introductory remarks and adoption of the agenda and programme of work

The director of the African Centre for Statistics at the Economic Commission for Africa (ECA), Oliver Chinganya, will welcome participants. Representatives of the major partners of ECA in the organization of the Forum on Statistical Development in Africa, namely, the African Development Bank, the African Union Commission, and the Partnership in Statistics for Development in the 21st Century, will make statements. Participants will then review and adopt the agenda and programme of work.

2. Opportunities, challenges and needs of national statistical systems

Under this agenda item, ECA will give a presentation on a strategic toolkit that has been developed to promote the transformation and modernization of official statistics in Africa. That will be followed by a presentation by a representative of one member of ECA on behalf of all members on the needs and priorities of national statistical systems in Africa. The presentation will be based on the results of a needs assessment survey conducted ahead of the meeting. The two presentations will be followed by a discussion to deepen the conversation on specific needs, priority areas of demand, and national perspectives.

3. Funding of national statistical systems

The Partnership in Statistics for Development in the 21st Century will give a presentation on the re-engineering of the management of national statistical systems and on mechanisms to accelerate advocacy and raise funds for the



development of official statistics. That will be followed by three presentations from representatives of members of ECA on models for funding national statistical systems.

4. Panel discussion on progress of statistical development at the national level

Under this agenda item, a panel discussion will be held with a focus on progress made by countries in transforming and modernizing their national statistical systems. Panellists and participants will also reflect on existing opportunities and challenges and the role of the Forum in advancing the transformation and modernization processes.

5. Contributions to statistical development in Africa

Under this agenda item, ECA will give a presentation on the Commission's medium-term statistics plan for the period 2025–2027. That will be followed by a presentation from one partner institution on behalf of all partners concerning offers and opportunities, areas of support (both technical and financial), and the interest of partners in supporting statistical development in Africa. The African Union Commission will give a presentation on progress made during the second phase of the Pan-African Statistics Programme. The Partnership in Statistics for Development in the 21st Century and the World Bank will present their respective activity reports.

The presentations will be followed by a discussion of the statistical support that partners provide to African countries, along with plans, strategies and initiatives to transform and modernize statistical systems in Africa.
