**2. From commitments to delivery: stocktaking of progress and
gaps**

Under this agenda item, ECA will begin by sharing the results of the implementation of the recommendations from the eleventh meeting of the Forum. There will be an opportunity for participants to request clarifications and offer their initial reactions.

Building on this stocktaking, a representative of [*country to be confirmed*], speaking on behalf of all African countries, will present countries' needs, priority areas of demand and experience of partner support, based on the results of the implementation of the recommendations of the eleventh meeting. This will be followed by a panel discussion guided by ECA with representatives of two members of ECA, the World Bank, the African Development Bank, the African Union Commission and the Partnership in Statistics for Development

in the 21st Century. Participants will then discuss how to close the gaps identified and seek to agree on renewed measurable commitments for the next two years, together with ways of strengthening accountability for delivery. The Chair will summarize the session.

3. Partnerships to advance the African Statistical System: financing, coordination and emerging priorities

Under this agenda item, on behalf of partners, ECA will present a summary of partners' support for statistical development in Africa. This will be followed by a panel discussion guided by ECA with representatives of two members of ECA, the United Nations Development Programme, the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization, the World Bank, the European Commission, the Partnership in Statistics for Development in the 21st Century and Bloomberg on:

- (a) Coordination, including vehicles for cooperation;
- (b) Strengthening data use, modernization and integration, and the responsible adoption of alternative and emerging data sources, including artificial intelligence;
- (c) Sustainable financing of statistical operations and mechanisms to ensure that resources reaching national statistical offices translate into country-level results.

The panel discussion will be followed by contributions from participants and a general discussion on maximizing the effectiveness of partners' support for the transformation and modernization of national statistical systems in Africa. The Chair will summarize the session.
